land—they had to destroy all the worship centers, all the idols, and all the names of the idols. However, the situation in Christianity shows how much these 3 things still prevail, not just in the Catholic church but also in the Protestant denominations.

God's grace is freely given in the New Testament, but as with everything that God does, He is balanced. He will only give us grace if we meet the demands of His regulation. And just as in the Old Testament time, His command to His elect was not only that they would destroy the 3 aforementioned items, but that they would go "to the place which Jehovah your God will choose...to put His name, to His habitation" (Deut 12:5). The New Testament reality of such a command is the God-ordained ground of oneness, which is the principle of meeting by locality, with one church in one city. It is only on this ground that God will pour out the blessing, because the church on the ground of oneness takes no name other than that of the Lord Jesus, and hence has His very presence and the eating, enjoyment, and rejoicing that come with His presence. It is here, in the place where man's individual preference and opinion are excluded (which are really just the lusts of our flesh to pick and choose according to our liking), that we enjoy the commanded blessing of the oneness seen in Psalm 133. The ground of oneness is an inherent cross to us, to deal with our natural life with its natural preferences and biases towards one person and against another. Just as the children of Israel eventually had to converge onto the same path up to Mount Zion, the place chosen by God, and were forced by the necessary restriction of God's choosing to reconcile with anyone they had an offense with on the way up, we too have to learn to allow God's choosing to terminate our natural preferences and submit to His arrangement of the members and His blending of the members. Then we will be brought into the practical and real oneness of the universal Body of Christ.
