### National: Gospelize, Truthize and Churchize America (GTCA) and upcoming Gospel Trips

The target cities for the 2014 GTCA burden are: Columbia, South Carolina; Edinburg, Texas; Fargo, North Dakota; Fayetteville, Arkansas; Fort Myers, Florida; Greeley, Colorado; Lafayette, Indiana; Lexington, Kentucky; Lincoln, Nebraska; Lubbock, Texas; Merced, California; Murfreesboro, Tennessee; Novato, California; Olympia, Washington; Omaha, Nebraska; Salem, Oregon; Stillwater, Oklahoma; Temecula, California; and Virginia Beach/Newport News, Virginia.

On Friday, January 24, teams of saints will visit many of these cities for one- and two-week gospel trips to spread the gospel, teach the truth, and help raise up churches in North America. Over 100 full-time trainees and many other saints from nearby supporting churches will participate with local saints in preaching the gospel, shepherding new ones, and giving away free BfA material.
