DETAILED PRAYER BURDENS

International: The Lord's move in Spain (*see report below*)

Two Spanish-speaking co-workers visited Spain from January 31 to February 11, 2013. During their visit, many seeking ones were contacted.

- ⊗ Pray that the Lord of the harvest will thrust out more workers into His harvest in Spain. The harvest is great, but the workers are few (Matt. 9:37-38).
- ⊗ Pray that the seeking believers in Palma de Mallorca will see a vision of the Lord's recovery, come out of their respective

sheepfolds, and gather together on the ground of oneness as the church.

- ⊗ Pray that the Lord will continue to provide the funds necessary to sustain the nationwide, daily Spanish language broadcasts of the Life-Study of the Bible.

Irvine Local Conference—March 2-3

- ⊗ Pray for the full release of the Lord's burden to the church and the saints' response to this burden that the Lord could bring the church further on into a prayer life and a gospel living.

Love Feast: Following the Lord's Day morning meetings, there will be a church-provided love feast. Please remain to enjoy the blending with the saints.

REPORT FROM SPAIN

Two Spanish-speaking co-workers visited Spain from Jan. 31 to Feb. 11, 2013. This visit was a result of fellowship between the brothers in Spain and the Spanish-speaking co-workers who have been involved with the radio broadcasting of the Life-Study in Spanish. The broadcasting of the Life-Studies in Spanish has been going on in Spain for a number of years but the number of stations broadcasting has changed depending on the availability of finances. At times, we had to limit ourselves to a few independent stations that were willing to broadcast for free. We have many radio listeners but have not had a concerted effort to harvest these seekers. Rhema has also been operating in Spain for a number of years.

Recently, all the churches have been encouraged to contact the readers of the ministry and to shepherd them into the church life. The purpose of the co-workers' visit was to hold symposiums for the radio listeners and Rhema readers so that we could get to know each other. A secondary purpose was to shepherd our own saints in several localities. The co-

workers' visit included symposiums in Madrid, Malaga, and Palma de Mallorca, a city on the Balearic Islands; live radio/TV interviews in the city of Murcia (2 stations) and Palma de Mallorca; and blending with the saints in Madrid, Murcia, Valencia, and Malaga.

Throughout the visit we took Ezekiel 36:37-38 as our prayer for Spain: *Thus says the Lord Jehovah, Moreover for this I will be inquired of by the house of Israel to do it for them; I will increase them with men like a flock. Like the holy flock for sacrifices, like the flock of Jerusalem in her appointed feasts, so will the waste cities be filled with flocks of men; and they will know that I am Jehovah.*

The main topics covered at the symposiums were Paul's conversion and the 2 great prayers of Paul in Ephesians 1 and 3. Most of the guests who attended the symposiums were radio listeners or Rhema readers. In Madrid, 7 guests came, in Palma de Mallorca 60 came the first night and another 60-70 came the follow-

ing night, and in Malaga a total of 68 guests came. After each symposium we opened the meeting for sharing, and many shared in a very good way concerning what they appreciated from the speaking and the light they received.

At the end of each symposium we informed the attendees about the entities that are propagating the ministry in Spain. We offered free New Testament Recovery Versions and will deliver them when they are available in late February/early March. Since the symposium guests already had warm hearts and many have been enjoying the ministry, a great majority of them requested a free New Testament, and many of them wanted to order the Holy Bible Recovery Version. Hallelujah! The believers who gathered in Palma de Mallorca belong to many denominations on the island, but they all know each other and are now even more connected as a result of enjoying the ministry either by radio or the Rhema books.

The radio/TV interviews were extremely well received. For the past year and a half, a brother in the church in Malaga has been contacting independent (associated with free groups) radio stations who were willing to broadcast the Life-Study radio programs. After listening to the sample programs that were sent to them and realizing the rich content, these and other stations were very willing to broadcast the programs free of charge. This visitation trip was to meet the pastors who lead the independent groups and are themselves the radio moderators, and to introduce them to

the co-workers as the voices they have been hearing. All the stations wanted our brothers to be on the air live with full freedom to speak whatever was on their heart to their listeners. The brothers shared on some topics of the truth, and the moderators asked questions. The interviews were open and frank and very well received by the stations. Callers were invited to asked questions on the air. The talks ranged from 1.5 hours to over 2 hours. These independent stations definitely want further contact with us and are happy to continue broadcasting the Life-Studies as part of their programming. In addition to the 6 stations covering 5 cities that are willing to broadcast the Life-Studies for free, we have recently renewed our agreement with RKM, a national Christian network, to broadcast on over 54 stations covering 52 cities. The cost has been discounted on a provisional basis, and the entire arrangement is subject to review in 3 months.

The visitation of the co-workers and the blending with the saints met a tremendous need. There are many new ones in all the localities that the brothers visited, and the fellowship uplifted and strengthened their vision of the recovery. The brothers' burden was to continue the line on prayer from the 2012 Thanksgiving Conference. They also shared the content of a recent Spanish-speaking conference in Southern California on prayer. The saints were greatly impressed by the need to be a person of prayer.

Pray Over These Key Verses...

Psa. 30:1: I extol You, O Jehovah, for You have drawn me up / And have not let my enemies rejoice over me.

S. S. 1:4: Draw me; we will run after you / The king has brought me into his chambers / We will be glad and rejoice in you; / We will extol your love more than wine. / Rightly do they love you.

Matt. 11:25: At that time Jesus answered and said, I extol You, Father, Lord of heaven and of earth, because You have hidden these things from the wise and intelligent and have revealed them to infants.

Read Some Helpful Ministry...

In His prayer the Lord extolled the Father, acknowledging the Father as Lord of heaven and of earth. To extol is to praise with acknowledgment. Mostly we give praise to the Lord without any acknowledgment, but the Lord praised the Father by acknowledging that the Father is the Lord of heaven and earth. We should learn to praise by acknowledging the Father in His economy, His will, and His doing (*The God-man Living*, p. 111).
