## DETAILED PRAYER BURDENS

### International: The Lord's Move in India

We praise the Lord for preserving this land for His move. Since the strengthening of the gospel move in India in 1997, the Lord has moved in this country to bring many saints into the Recovery. There are now 96 churches across India, with many good testimonies testifying the Spirit's move here.

However, it is our belief that the Lord can do much more in this vast and strategically important country. People's hearts are still soft and simple toward God. Here we can freely preach to Hindus, Muslims and seeking Christians. During February 6-12, the co-workers based in the Delhi area plus full-time trainees and some other saints gathered for one week to pray and prepare for the Lord's intensified move. Those who joined the gathering can testify that the Spirit moved in an unprecedented way—our spirits were released and burning, there were upper room consecrations for the propagation in Delhi and Gurgaon.

On the final day we were just beside ourselves—we prayed strongly in one accord that the Lord grant us a great many newly baptized ones and remaining fruits in 2012. We brothers laid hands on the consecrations made by different propagation teams. It was like a spiritual storm described in Ezekiel 1, where the Spirit of God blew like a mighty wind to move us to repent of our sins, of our lack in practicing and living out the vision that we have seen, and cause us to be desperate for His desire: to gain a corporate testimony of those who live the life of a God-man by realizing the power of the resurrected and ascended Christ.

- ☉ Pray that the Lord would remember all the consecrations made, that the Spirit would

continue to blow strongly across India to bring all the churches into the same flow of the Spirit, so that the Lord would gain a breakthrough in us this year.

- ☉ Pray the high and awesome wheels move in India to prepare for the last and greatest revival that will bring us all the way back to Jerusalem to receive the Lord's return.

### National: GTCA

- ☉ Pray for the Spirit to create a seeking in many of the Lord's people in this country for the experience of Christ and the genuine church life.
- ☉ Pray that the ministry of the age would reach them and that they would see the vision of the age and be brought into the Lord's recovery for the building up of His Body.
- ☉ Continue to pray for the 17 GTCA cities where the recent gospel trips took place.

## CHURCH-WIDE BLENDING MEETING ON LORD'S DAY, MARCH 4

On Lord's Day, March 4, the church in Irvine will have a church-wide blending meeting at UCI in the Student Center from 9:30am-noon. During this gathering we will also hold our annual business meeting. The annual business meeting is held once a year to conduct a few formal matters of the church (such as the election of directors) as required by California law. While seemingly unrelated to spiritual affairs (the realm in which the church mostly exists and functions), the Bible nevertheless charges every person to "be subject to the authorities over him, for there is no authority except from God, and those which exist are ordained by God" (Rom. 13:1). While the church holds fast to Christ as its unique Head, for it to subject itself to the state in which it is legally incorporated is actually to recognize

God's authority and to respect His government over man.

Following the meeting there will be a church-catered love feast. Due to the financial situation of the church, the saints are asked to provide a small donation toward the love-feast and the parking permits, costs which are normally covered by the church. A donation for the love feast of \$5 per person can be made in the offering boxes. The church will also make available one paid parking permit per household in advance (see district responsible brothers). Those who have the means to do so can offer an additional \$10 to cover the cost to the church for their parking. To reduce congestion and fees, please carpool as much as possible.

## WORD OF THE WEEK: "LINGER"

### Pray Over These Key Verses...

Gen. 18:16: And the men rose up from there and looked down upon Sodom. And Abraham walked with them to send them away. 17 And Jehovah said, Shall I hide from Abraham what I am about to do, 22 And the men turned from there and went toward Sodom, while Abraham remained standing before Jehovah. 33 And Jehovah went away as soon as He had finished speaking with Abraham, and Abraham returned to his place.

### Read Some Helpful Ministry...

Although God remained at Abraham's tent door for several hours, talking a great deal to him, God did not say a word about His purpose in coming to secure an intercessor. We often act in the same way. Perhaps you want a brother to do a certain thing for you. If you are wise, you will not come to him and immediately ask him to do what you desire. You will first determine his mood by having a talk with him about various matters. At the very end of your visit, as the brother is seeing you to the door or conducting you on your way, you may open yourself to him and tell him of your desire. However, if he does not linger with you but says, "See you in the meeting tonight," you will realize that his heart is too cold and that he would not be interested in doing what you want him to do. But if he says, "I would like to stay with you for a while

longer," then you will know that you can open yourself to him.

When God came to Abraham, Abraham welcomed Him, providing Him water and serving Him a good meal. Although God spoke to Abraham during the preparation and eating of the meal, He did not disclose the purpose for which He came. Only when God rose up and walked away from the tent and Abraham accompanied and conducted Him and the two angels on their way, did God tell Abraham of His intention. (*Life-Study of Genesis*, Chapter 51, Section 2)

Whenever we have the deep sense that God has come to us on a human level, we shall realize that this is the time when God will initiate an intercession for us to carry out. For this we must learn to linger in the presence of God. If He would begin to walk away, we must stay in His presence and tell Him, "Lord, I don't want to lose Your presence. I want to linger here with You." Your lingering in His presence will open up His heart and draw out His desire. We have seen that Abraham did not abruptly say good-bye to the Lord but walked with Him for a certain distance. This reveals that, in a certain sense, God is very human. (*Abraham—Called by God*, Chapter 15)
