their strong desire to go to the FTT. The young people are so burning for the Lord, especially in gospel preaching. We had a week of Bible distribution, distributing over 900 Bibles, and we also conducted a seminar with 28 new contacts.

In addition, we had the Perfecting Training in Sao Roque over the topic of ITERO: The Unique Work in the Lord's Recovery, and the Thanksgiving Conference: Prayer and the Lord's Move. The Lord really poured out His blessing and His burden through His word released to the saints. I was encouraged to see the saints enter into the burden. There was a

word encouraging saints from Brazil to attend FTTParaguay.

One major prayer burden I have is for the saints in Brazil, especially for the young adults. Please pray that they would continue pursuing the Lord in a healthy way and that the Lord would open the way for many young adults (especially Adriano and Rodrigo for Fall 2013) to come to the FTTA.
