Dear saints,

We were very impressed with the sharing from the Thanksgiving Day conference messages regarding prayer, and particularly how Brother Lee prayed for the Lord's recovery in the United States. The direction of our prayers has recently been focused on the Lord gaining the right and useful vessels for His recovery here in Greece, particularly that He would bring young brothers who have a good command of the English language so that they could be constituted with the wealth of the ministry available in this language.

With this in mind, a number of us will be traveling to Thessaloniki next week to contact several of the readers of the ministry there. We will have an "open house" type gathering where these readers can come together to fellowship and be in the ministry. They are also encouraged to bring those whom they feel may be interested, and our prayer is that the Lord would bring some of these young seeking ones. Our desire is that the Lord would be able to

take a concrete step this year in Thessaloniki by gaining a completely open home where these ministry readers and seekers can meet regularly, with the proper brothers who could take the lead to help them do this.

Last, we are still waiting for our residence permits to be released. We have a strong desire to be able to attend the corporate gatherings of the saints, particularly the International Conference and the European Brothers Training in London. We believe these times are crucial to us for the mutual supply, blending, and fellowship. Without a renewed residence permit, however, we are not allowed to leave the country except to travel to the United States. We are so very grateful that we are not here by ourselves. We are so thankful that you are standing with us. May the Lord gain something particular in Greece in 2013!
