International:

European Responsible Brothers' Training—April 20-21

Responsible brothers and serving ones from all over Europe and from Israel will gather in London to view the messages given in the recent International Training for Elders and Responsible Ones (ITERO).

- ⊗ Please pray that the burden of the Lord's speaking will penetrate into all the brothers for the advancement of the Lord's move in Europe and Israel.

International Conference in London—April 22-24

- ⊗ Please pray for the gathering and blending of the saints from all over Europe and the Lord's rich anointing on His word.

Africa—Perfecting Training, Weekend Conference, and Elders' and Responsible Ones' Training

There will be another perfecting training held in Accra, Ghana for the saints in West Africa. This will be the eighth such training. The duration of the training will be two weeks with classes stressing truth, life, the church, and the gospel. Following the training there will also be a weekend conference both in Accra, Ghana and in Lagos, Nigeria. Finally, there will be an ITERO in Accra for the elders and responsible ones for the entire region. The brothers will be pursuing the same material that was released April 1-3 in Anaheim. All of these times have been edifying thus far, but still need the prayer and strengthening of the Body.

- ⊗ Please pray that the Lord would head up the training, in all the coordination, classes, and atmosphere.
- ⊗ Please pray that the atmosphere of the perfecting training would be high and the exercise of the spirit would be strong.
- ⊗ Please pray that the conference would be full of the Lord's fresh, up-to-date speaking, the time would be full of light, and

the Lord would use the word He releases to take the churches on.
