- ☉ In the upper right-hand corner, log in using either a facebook or google account and click allow access.

- ☉ Once you are logged in, click on the “My Group” tab.
- ☉ Enter the group key **KJBFKD** into the text box and click “Join a Group”.
- ☉ To post a ready entry, click on the “My Reading” tab.
- ☉ In the text box type in the book and chapter you read, e.g., 1 Cor. 1 or Rom. 2, and click “Post a Reading.”
