REPORT FROM THE SAINTS IN ROME

Dear saints,

Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. In the past four weeks or so, many of us have been blending with the saints and churches in Europe, while attending the European college-age conference, European brothers' training, and International conference in London.

The recent college-age conference in Wales hosted approximately three-hundred college students from all over Europe, six of whom were from Rome and four of whom were typical Italian university students. We feel that the presence of these young ones under such a rich speaking and in an atmosphere of blending with so many other European students was a great encouragement both to them and to us. Please continue to pray that those who have not been baptized would be released to take this next step and that they would be brought into the church life.

On the last night of the conference all the Italian-speaking saints gathered together for a time of singing, along with a brother from Spain and a few others. Some of the brothers and sisters had translated some short hymns so that we could sing them in Italian. As we were singing, there was a gradual accumulating of saints until there were about one hundred of us singing "Ti amo Signore," or "Lord, I just love You". We continued to sing this over and over again until around 11pm, yet each time it

seemed sweeter and sweeter. The atmosphere was precious and anointed to the uttermost. This may have been the highlight of the whole weekend for many of us who came from Italy, and we would even dare to say, for many of the students from all over Europe.

Regarding the campus work, it seems good that we would take the next step by having a campus meeting during the week at both La Sapienza and Roma Tre. (Founded in 1303, La Sapienza is the largest European university with approximately 140 thousand students.) This meeting will be with the students who are saved and have been baptized by us, as well as with the contacts that we currently have there and any friends who would desire to join us. At present we have about ten students at La Sapienza who have all received the Lord or are already believers and are meeting with us. There is another student whom we are very burdened for on this campus. In addition, there are five students at Roma Tre. Earlier this week, while distributing "The Mystery of Human Life" tract, a first-year male student called on the name of the Lord and was desirous to meet with us on the campus next week for a follow-up appointment. We are particularly burdened that one male contact at Roma Tre will receive the Lord. Pray for the campus meetings at these two universities and for the students and their contacts.

We have also had the burden to get into the homes of those who have been saved and baptized by us, including the students. Last week we had dinner with one of the families. We have been in their home on numerous occasions, and we are praying that several of the family members will be saved. The father has received the Lord and has been to five home meetings thus far. Please also pray for home meetings to be established in the homes of several of our students and that their parents and families will be saved for the Lord's interest.

Twice a week, on Wednesday nights and Saturday afternoons, three saints have been door-knocking in the San Lorenzo area. At present we have visited approximately one thousand homes. Some have prayed to receive

the Lord, and two people have joined our home meeting in the area. We are also looking to begin door-knocking in the Policlinico-Ippocrate area and the Bologna-Nemorense area in addition to the Dei Sardi-San Lorenzo region, where many students live. Please pray that the Lord will find and manifest His sons of peace in these three areas to gain some Italian families and open Italian homes.

We are burdened to have twelve remaining typical Italians by the time of the Lord's table in June. May the Lord perfect an unprecedented one accord and harmony in coordination, as the master key of the divine blessings, among the local churches and in the Lord's work around the globe (Acts 1:14).
