DETAILED PRAYER BURDENS

Like many of the trainees described in one of our overflow times, the trip was very personal to many of us. For the first time, the gospel trip was in May and not in January (like it usually is), which allowed for an opportunity to join in to labor, serve, and live with the FTTL trainees (in January, most of the FTTL trainees are on break). This was a really sweet time of blending. I can really say that by blending, many of these brothers have been written on my heart. Europe isn't some kind of abstract thing that I have to give myself to; but now, Europe has a face, it's the face of the trainees and saints who have been faithful to just move and be there for the Lord's shining testimony.

Anyways, there is a lot, lot, lot more concerning the actual trip, but I wanted to keep the update relatively short so you all would read it!

I'll end with a verse that a brother shared that really touched me. 2 Peter 1:19 talks about the morning star rising in our hearts. Before the Lord returns as the morning star at the end of this age, He first needs to rise as the morning star in our hearts.
