DETAILED PRAYER BURDENS

International: The Lord's Testimony in Germany Local: South Orange County and Irvine

A young couple from Taiwan has been living and working at a medical university in Freiburg, Germany, for the past two years. The Lord's testimony in Germany began in Freiburg in the early 1970s. This couple has contacted several German students and meets regularly with them. Their visa will expire next month, and unless the Lord opens a way, they will have to return to Taiwan. The students will attend the conference in Germany on 11-13 June. Please pray:

- ☉ That the Lord will open a way for the couple to continue to live and serve in Freiburg.
- ☉ That the Lord will fully gain the German students for His testimony in Freiburg.

National: Memorial Weekend Conference

- ☉ Pray that the word released in the past Memorial Day conference would operate in the churches that all the saints would treasure and pursue a deeper and richer experience of the crucial elements of the Bible: Christ, the Spirit, life and the church.

- ☉ Pray for the blending gatherings of the South Coast churches this Lord's Day that the burden released in the Memorial Day conference would penetrate the saints and that this blending would result in the growth of the divine life in the churches and the strengthening of the one accord among the churches.

SOUTH COUNTY CHURCHES BLENDING ON LORD'S DAY, JUNE 5

On Lord's Day, June 5, 2011, the five churches in South Orange County—Huntington Beach, Santa Ana, Irvine, Lake Forest, and San Juan Capistrano—will blend together by sending a small number of saints from each locality to the rest of the other churches. Through this five-way blending in all the local churches, we hope to encourage an increase in the circulation and flow of life within this cluster of churches.

To facilitate the blending, all five churches will be digesting the same message from the Memorial Day Conference, currently being held in Dallas, Texas. In each locality, the saints will enjoy the Lord's Table together followed by the digestion of Message 1, entitled "The Crucial Elements of the Bible—Christ, the Spirit, Life, the Church." If any saint was unable to catch this message (either live or via webcast), the message can be accessed at www.lsmwebcast.com under "Recent Conference Archives." The audio file is also available for download for a nominal fee of \$1 at the same location.

Due to physical occupancy limitations in each church, the brothers coordinating this blending have deemed it best to limit the number of saints that each of the other churches

can send to their own locality. The following is the number of saints that the other four South County churches have indicated they are willing to receive from the church in Irvine:
