Pray Over These Key Verses...

Matt. 5:8: Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God.

Psa. 24:3: Who may ascend the mountain of Jehovah, / And who may stand in His holy place? 4a He who has clean hands and a pure heart.

2 Cor. 11:2: For I am jealous over you with a jealousy of God; for I betrothed you to one husband to present you as a pure virgin to Christ. 3 But I fear lest somehow, as the serpent deceived Eve by his craftiness, your thoughts would be corrupted from the simplicity and the purity toward Christ.

Phil. 2:15: That you may be blameless and guileless, children of God without blemish in the midst of a crooked and perverted generation, among whom you shine as luminaries in the world,

Read Some Helpful Footnotes...

Matt. 5:8, note 1: To be pure in heart is to be single in purpose, to have the single goal of accomplishing God's will for

God's glory (1 Cor. 10:31). This is for the kingdom of the heavens. Our spirit is the organ by which we receive Christ (John 1:12; 3:6), whereas our heart is the ground where Christ as the seed of life grows (13:19). For the kingdom of the heavens we need to be poor in spirit, empty in our spirit, that we may receive Christ. Also, we need to be pure, single, in our heart that Christ may grow in us without frustration.

1 Tim. 1:5, note 3: A pure heart is a single heart without mixture, a heart that seeks only the Lord and takes the Lord as the unique goal. A good conscience is a conscience without offense (Acts 24:16). Unfeigned faith, related to the faith mentioned in v. 4, is faith without pretense or hypocrisy, faith that purifies the heart (Acts 15:9) and operates through love (Gal. 5:6). In the trend of the church's decline and in dealing with the different teachings, all these attributes are required for us to have a pure, true, and genuine love.
