### International: Nordic countries conference in Oslo, Norway—July 29-31

A conference for the saints in the Nordic countries (Sweden, Norway, and Finland) will be held in Oslo, Norway from July 29-31. At the end of the conference the saints will enjoy the first Lord's table in Oslo to initiate the church life there.

- ⊗ Pray for the rich release of the Lord's word and the raising up of a strong testimony in the Nordic countries.
- ⊗ Pray that last week's tragedy would turn out to salvation for many native Norwegians and open the door for the gospel.

### Young people's camp in Poland—July 24-30

Please pray for the European Young People's Conference in Poland.

### Sendai, Japan

We have been here five days. It has been glorious, and the Lord has really been moving. Since the earthquake and tsunami, the Lord has saved many Japanese through the gospel preaching and the main focus of the U.S. team this time is following up on and shepherding the new ones. In the past five days we have

been able to spend quality time in their homes and in our apartments with some of the open ones. However, there has been a barrier concerning the matter of baptism. We feel we are engaged in a spiritual battle regarding this matter with a few of our contacts and may continue to run into this issue with other contacts. We desperately need the prayers of the churches to overthrow the strongholds of the enemy for a full release and transfer of these contacts into the kingdom of God.

- ⊗ Please pray for key contacts to be baptized and enter the church life.
- ⊗ Please pray for household salvation for the spouses and children of the local saints.
- ⊗ Please pray for the blending of the U.S. team with the Japanese saints under the unique Headship in the one flow.
- ⊗ Please pray for the shepherding of the new ones and for some saints, especially couples, to migrate to Sendai for the care of the new ones.

- ⊗ Pray for the second week of the summer school of truth.

### Pray Over These Key Verses...

Psa. 16:8: I have set Jehovah before me continually; / Because He is at my right hand, I shall not be shaken.

Psa. 34:1: I will bless Jehovah at all times; / His praise will continually be in my mouth.

Phil. 1:19: For I know that for me this will turn out to salvation through your petition and the bountiful supply of the Spirit of Jesus Christ.

Phil. 2:12: So then, my beloved, even as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only but now much rather in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling;

1 Thes. 5:16-18: Always rejoice, unceasingly pray, in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.

### Read Some Helpful Footnotes...

Phil. 2:12, note 4, par.2: In ch. 1 salvation comes through the bountiful supply of the Spirit of Jesus Christ, but here salvation comes from the operating God within us. The operating God is actually the Spirit of Jesus Christ. In both these cases salvation is a **practical, daily, moment-by-moment** salvation. The constant salvation in 1:19 is one in which a particular believer is saved from a specific encounter in a particular situation; whereas the **constant salvation in 2:12 is one in which any believer is saved from ordinary things in common situations in his daily living.**

1 Thes. 5:17, note 1 (Unceasingly): This is to have **uninterrupted fellowship with God in our spirit. It requires perseverance** (Rom. 12:12; Col. 4:2) with a strong spirit (Eph. 6:18).
