DETAILED PRAYER BURDENS

<u>International</u>: The Effect of the ITERO on the **⊗** Leading Ones and the Churches in Europe

A total of 820 elders and responsible brothers from 51 countries attended the fall ITERO in Baarlo, Netherlands, on October 6-8. Approximately 249 brothers were from Europe, and 106 were from the Russian speaking world. The Lord has done much to spread and establish His testimony in Europe since the devastation caused by the turmoil in the late 1980s. In the past 12 years the number of saints meeting in Europe has increased almost 5 times over. At present there are 73 churches in 23 countries with 2550 saints, and there are an additional 62 cities in Europe where saints are meeting who have not yet begun to take the Lord's table. Praise Him for His victory over His enemy in Europe!

- Please pray that the Lord will firmly establish the four great pillars of truth, life, the church, and the gospel in all the churches in Europe.
- Please pray that the Lord will continue to blend the co-workers, leading brothers, churches, and saints in Europe for the mutual building up of the Body of Christ and the manifestation of the one new man.

Please pray that the Lord will continue to spread His testimony in Europe and raise up golden lampstands in more cities across Europe.
