Follow-up Care of Rhema Contacts in Europe

Over the past decade many thousands of seeking ones in Europe have received free ministry publications through Rhema. After reading all the free publications available to them, several thousand appreciators of the ministry have become distributors in their home countries.

The Spreading of the Ministry on the Internet in South America

A group of saints have been working on social networking websites to contact the New Testament Recovery Version recipients in South America from the 2010 and 2011 distributions, sending regular Bible study e-mails based on the *Basic Elements of the Christian Life* to those who filled out the contact cards. Also, Facebook and Twitter pages both in Portuguese and Spanish are being used to reach people who have not received the Recovery Version, allowing them to request Bibles or get in contact with their local distribution center. Bible studies and comments and verses from users are being posted on a weekly basis. We have thousands of active users, many of whom are actively following us and asking questions. These tools are available for all the saints to participate in for the propagation of the Word and the ministry. Please join us in prayer.

- ⊗ Pray that these resources would be used to bring the New Testament Recovery Version and the riches of the ministry of the age to God's hungry seekers.

- ⊗ Pray for the response of those who are being contacted through e-mail that they could become remaining fruit.

National:

Bibles for America Reading Group Begins Nov. 7

Over 9,000 people who received *Basic Elements of the Christian Life, vol. 1* in August and September will be invited to participate in BfA's second online Reading Group. The Reading Group will start on November 7 and cover the five chapters of *Basic Elements of the Christian Life, vol. 1*.

The Reading Group is similar to a face-to-face "book club" in which participants read the material and then discuss what they learned or experienced from the reading with one another. The online Reading Group will be conducted via a blog in which recipients and saints, who are functioning as facilitators, will fellowship by commenting on the blog posts.

Please pray that the Reading Group will:
