I'm officially back in Madrid, beginning my second language program. Thankfully, this time around, there are not only saints in the city but also another sister from Berkeley in the same program as myself. Praise the Lord that I have a companion. I remember near the end of my time before I left, praying desperately that there would be another college student with me in Madrid, and lo and behold :).

Madrid, especially the university I'm attending, Complutense, does not usually have many college students, Spaniard or international. However, this year, there will be us two students attending. In addition, there are two young couples who graduated from FTTL who will be serving full time in Madrid. Therefore, this year the saints have the burden to begin and establish a gospel work on this campus. Complutense is the oldest and most prestigious university in Spain, and has at least 2 locations, located in various parts of Madrid. Some students received Bibles this past winter during the FTTA gospel trip, but no presence

was fully established from my understanding. A prayer request is that the Lord would really use this year and use us to establish a continuing and fruitful gospel work on the campus. Honestly, I'm quite terrified at the prospect of preaching the gospel in Spanish. It's hard enough in English. But I've been appreciating the vision of the self. We have to realize what the self is, because without knowing what the self is and rejecting it, we will not be able to build up the Body. So Amen to putting aside the self and taking Christ as my Person, in every aspect of my living, in order to build up the Body! The Lord only supplies us with a DAILY amount, not enough for the future but only for today. So I shouldn't worry about preaching the gospel in the future, but simply enjoy my portion of Christ today! :)
