International:

The Lord's Move among the University Students in Europe

On November 18-20 a conference for the university students in Europe was held at Bower House in London. A total of 171 university students attended the conference, including 133 from the UK and Ireland and 38 from 10 countries outside the UK. During the conference 5 students were baptized.

- ⊗ Please pray for the training of the European students to be the corporate gospel seed on their campuses, serving in a coordinated way.
- ⊗ Please pray for the gaining of local European students.
- ⊗ Please pray for the families who are willing to open their homes to migrate near to major campuses in London, UK, and throughout Europe.

city," Chapel Hill, NC, in regards to the GTCA burden. We prayed weekly based initially on the wemigrate.org website's status updates, and later based on the fellowship with local brothers in Chapel Hill. Not knowing who He would send, all we could say was "Lord, here we are – send us."

We went: In early October, the Lord opened a way for us to go by practically providing a job for John in North Carolina. We believe our being able to go is just one of many results of the accumulated prayers at the incense altar. We realize our going is not by ourselves, nor for ourselves.

We testify: Going out not knowing has made us more desperate for the Lord's appearing and deepened our knowing of the Body a little more. Stripped of many outward considerations, it has forced us to seek not earthly matters, but the Lord in His Body, while claiming His word that "all these things would be added."

Prayer Burden: Please pray for the Lord's timing and way as to when the saints here will be gathered to break bread and meet as the church in Chapel Hill. Pray that there would be a strong beginning for a bright and shining testimony for the Lord.

WORD OF THE WEEK: "APPRECIATE"

Pray Over These Key Verses...

Phil. 3:7: But what things were gains to me, these I have counted as loss on account of Christ. **8** But moreover I also count all things to be loss on account of the excellency of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord, on account of whom I have suffered the loss of all things and count them as refuse that I may gain Christ.

Read Some Helpful Footnotes...

Gal. 2:16, note 1: Faith in Jesus Christ denotes an organic union with Him through believing. This is related to the believers' appreciation of the person of the Son of God as the most precious One. The believers are infused with the preciousness of Christ through the gospel preached to them. This Christ becomes in them the faith by which they believe and the capacity to believe through their appreciation of Him. This faith creates an organic union in which they and Christ are one.

Read Some Helpful Ministry...

In the Song of Songs, we see one who sought the Lord, and by her seeking, she found Him. Having found Him, she began to have sweet fellowship with Him....In her fellowship, first of all, the seeking one had a real appreciation of the Lord. She appreciated the Lord as a bundle of myrrh within and as a cluster of henna flowers without. She sought the Lord, she found the Lord, and in her fellowship with the Lord, she began to appreciate Him. Following this appreciation, there was the enjoyment—she said that her beloved was like an apple tree. An apple tree is not only for appreciation, but also for enjoyment. First of all, she had the appreciation, and then she came into the enjoyment of eating the fruit of the apple tree under its shadow.
