International: French-speaking Young People's Conference (Feb 27- Mar 1)

Over 120 young people and serving ones from Belgium, France and Switzerland will gather outside of Paris for the second annual French-speaking Young People's conference.

REPORT FROM SCOTLAND

In February the saints in Scotland are having a series of Life-study seminars for the local radio listeners and the Bible and Rhema recipients. On Lord's Day, February 8, the first seminar was held in the city of Edinburgh. A total of 50 attended, of whom 5 were brand new, 10 have been with us less than 6 months, and 3 asked for home Bible studies.

On Lord's day, February 15, we had our second seminar in Stirling, a town of 50,000 people, midway between Edinburgh and Glasgow. We hope to establish a lampstand in this town in the near future. A total of 43 attended this seminar. The atmosphere was very warm and welcoming, and we believe the Lord really blessed the harmonious coordination between all the saints. Among the attendees, 12 (5 from

Stirling) have been meeting with us for less than 6 months, 2 were brand new, and both of these requested home Bible studies.

After the seminar many of the new ones lingered to enjoy further fellowship with us. They did not leave until the venue closed, and some of them invited our saints into their homes for dinner that evening. Please pray for the Lord's move in Scotland, that all of these new ones will be added to the churches here and that the Lord will bless the remaining seminars.

Thank you for all your support. We hope that some saints from Bratislava will be able to join us in March. We feel very much supplied and covered by the prayers of the churches and the saints all over the earth. Hallelujah for the one flow of His move!
