Children's Service

We have a need for saints to serve with the children during the conference. We are encouraging any saints with children to consider serving at least one meeting, either at the

conference on Saturday or on Lord's Day in Irvine.

The Saturday sessions are 3:15-6:30 pm or 6:15-9:30 pm. Note that the children's service will be provided at the former training center at 1853 W. Ball Road, not at the Ministry Conference Center on La Palma Ave. We will have full children's service, including an opening time, a story, a lesson, crafts, games, and a snack during each session. We are also planning to provide a simple pizza meal during the dinner break since we anticipate that there will not be enough time for parents to travel back and forth from Ball Rd. to La Palma during the break.

We will divide the children into smaller groups, and each group will need a team of serving ones to take care of the children. A team leader will be designated ahead of time for each group who will know all the details of the arrangement. We simply need you to come a little ahead of time (at 3:15 pm or 6:15 pm) for some orientation and then be ready to follow along with what has been prepared.
