accuser. It was brought up in class that if we remain in a state of looking at ourselves (being accused), God cannot conclude this age. We have to believe in the blood. We should not believe the accuser (the devil). We have the blood that casts down the accuser.

I got assigned to Orange, CA for the campus team. There are two subgroups—one for Chapman University and another for Santiago Canyon College (SSC). I am in the SSC subgroup. The saints here are so sweet. When I arrived to the prayer meeting in Orange on Tuesday night, the room was filled with a sweet fragrance. There were babies sitting on their parent's lap and toddlers walking around. It is a very cozy atmosphere. Interesting note: A sister from Chapman and I had started praying for Orange in 2011 and periodically since then. In 2011, there was only 1 or 2 home

meetings from what I remember. Now, there is a brothers' house, a sisters' house, many home meetings and many families. I think it's funny how the Lord placed me here, now in 2015. It is really amazing to see the saints here shining brightly (amazing to be somewhere you had prayed for previously).
