NEPAL EARTHQUAKE REPORT

Dear saints,

We would like to inform you that all the local saints in Nepal are safe after the massive earthquake on April 25 that took over 5,000 lives. A sister's house in Kathmandu and 6-7 houses of the saints in Maldi were damaged, but overall the saints are fine.

However, there was a Chinese brother who lost his life in this earthquake. He was saved in 2012 while studying in Hong Kong. He then went to Japan for work and was on vacation in Kathmandu when the earthquake hit. Please remember his relatives and friends in your prayer that they would be comforted and saved.

The current urgent need for the saints in Nepal is food and water. Two co-workers from India will be traveling to Kathmandu to coordinate with the local brothers on relief efforts. They will bring cash, food and water supplies into Nepal. The banks in Nepal are not operating at the moment. Therefore offering to this relief effort has to be through banks outside of Nepal.

Please pray for the country's recovery after the earthquake and for people's hearts to be open to the gospel at this time of trial. Also may we pray that the local saints would grasp the opportunity to boldly preach Christ as the Prince of Peace and lead many to salvation.

Currently there are about 170 saints meeting in 3 cities in Nepal: Kathmandu, Maldi, and Pokhara. Three Rhema booklets in Nepalese for free distribution are almost ready for print. May the Lord use these booklets to reach many seekers all over Nepal.

MIGRATION TO HUNGARY

Dear Saints,

We would like to thank the Church with all the saints for the prayer, love, and shepherding that we have received here over the past six years. Praise the Lord! He is now moving us to the country of Hungary in Eastern Europe.

For the past two years there has been a lot of prayer and fellowship with saints both here and in Europe regarding our going. Each time we considered our capacity and maturity in life we felt utterly unqualified to undertake such a move for the Lord's testimony. However we are learning to lift up our eyes from ourselves to the Lord and to seek out and trust the fellowship in the Body.

Currently there is no Lord's Table meeting in Hungary but approximately fifteen saints do meet together regularly in Budapest. The saints are prayerfully looking to the Lord for the time to take the ground. In addition to the saints in Budapest there are smaller groups meeting in homes in two other cities, Tata and Dunaujváros. Also, there are two brothers in Debrecen. They are first year medical students. One brother is from New Zealand and the

other from Michigan. Not knowing each other they both enrolled into the same medical program last September.

Starting on May 11 there will be a one week training in London at Bower House. I will be joining six saints from Hungary. This will be the first time that a group of Hungarian saints will go to a one week training in London. May the Lord take a big step in every Hungarian saint attending.

We pray that the Lord would continue to lead us in finding our place and function in this new situation, for the upcoming one week training in London and for the taking of the ground in Budapest in the near future.

We will miss you all. On your next trip to Europe please come to visit us.
