This term I have really been enjoying my personal time with the Lord, just learning to spend time with the Lord, learning to open to Him about specific matters and allowing Him to come into those parts and spread Himself. In one of the classes, the brother shared that God accomplishes His economy by dispensing Himself as life into a group of people. Then they would allow Him the freedom to spread into their being, their experiences, their decisions, their emotion, etc. Just allowing. This might not seem to solve our problems. We can cooperate with Him by opening up these parts of our being in a specific and detailed way, allowing Him to dispense Himself into those parts. I had some concepts about how my second term should be, but it did not turn out to be the way I wanted it. But praise the Lord that all these situations and arrangements are so that I can be open to Him, and allow more God to be dispensed into me.
