It is a matter of what is being constituted into my being.

At the same time, I have faith that each circumstance that I am going through right now is all under the divine dispensing. God is still working, even when I do not feel like He is. I must thank the Lord for everything He is putting me through. He is a sovereign God and He knows what is best for me, for His purpose, for His Body.
