International: Gospel trips to Europe (January 21 through June)

The Lord's blessing has been poured out on the FTTA gospel trip to Germany. A good number of refugees have received the Lord and are open to have regular contact. One report in particular was of a crying refugee man who stated, "I am so upset that God waited 37 years to save me! I have spent my whole life fearing God, but now He is nothing but love!"

Several of the hired translators have received the Lord and are very positive toward us and our labor with the refugees. One of our translators opened to us and told us that he felt that he was the one lost sheep in the parable in Luke 15. We led him to pray, and he received the Lord! He was very happy and began to call us his "brothers, sisters, my family." Regular reports and updates can be found at facebook.com/germanyupdate.

- ☉ Please pray that the Lord will continue to gain translators who will become our co-workers long term for the labor among the refugees.
- ☉ Pray that the local saints, together with those who are migrating to Germany, will continue and follow up the labor from the gospel trips with regular contact, shepherding, and opening of their homes.
- ☉ Pray that the enemy's frustrations will be bound and that we will have favor with

the refugee camp administrators and the refugees.

- ☉ Pray for the continuing labor of the seven follow-up gospel trips.

International Chinese-Speaking Conference (February 12-14)

- ☉ Pray that this time would be under the blessing of the Lord's presence and His rich dispensing that the churches would be strengthened and supplied with the Lord's word.
- ☉ Pray for the saints receiving of the word that is released that it would operate to strengthen the Lord's testimony for His manifestation in all the churches on this earth.

LETTER FROM THE CHURCH IN BUDAPEST, HUNGARY

Dear saints,

Related to the first Lord's Table meeting, the saints in Budapest, Hungary would like to express our heartfelt thanks to you for sending the Fodor family – Andras, Lisa, and Joseph – to Hungary. We have been greatly supplied and strengthened in their coming. Especially evident to us has been the supply in the areas of translation, an open home, another responsible brother, and the seed of a children's work.

The need for English/Hungarian translation has hampered our participation in the blending with other countries, in our meetings, and in our day-to-day fellowship. Since the addition of brother Andras as a translator, blending has become possible with other countries, the effectiveness of translation in the meetings has improved substantially, and the fellowship among the saints has been facilitated greatly. Andras is participating actively in oral translation and also in the written translation of the ministry so that we are able to translate and publish both ministry books and a good amount of the current speaking.

Another area of need we have had in Budapest is open homes where the Hungarian language is spoken. After the Fodor family

arrived in Budapest last summer, they found and purchased a proper house, not too far from the meeting place, close to Joseph's school, and comfortable for home meetings. Already this home has been very useful for the gathering of the saints and the Fodors are praying for many more gatherings in their home.

The addition of another constituted brother with some experience in bearing responsibility for the church life has also been a great strengthening. The coming of Joseph, as our first child, has been a great joy and encouragement to us, that the Lord will add more young ones to us in His time and in His way.

Finally, we would like to ask you to join us, as the Lord leads you, to continue to pray for the Fodor family. Much prayer is needed for the time of adjusting from a large, flourishing church life to a small, developing church life; from the American culture to the Hungarian culture; and from the English language to the Hungarian language.

May He bless and make His church in Budapest and His church in Irvine flourishing and fruitful!
