- ☉ Pray for the positive translators to be gained as real co-laborers in the gospel.


Follow-up to the Winter Gospel Trips

REPORT FROM GERMANY

We felt that the Lord blessed and covered us during the entire FTTA gospel trip. Many of the saints testified that, as they went out and spoke, they felt that the prayer of the saints was covering them and opening the way in the gospel. The greatest response was with the refugees, but there was also a very positive response among the German young people on the university campuses. There were also some very positive experiences with the hired trans-

lators. There was one case where a group was not allowed to go into a refugee camp, so they spent the rest of that day enjoying *The Mystery of Human Life* with their translator. Later in the same trip, their translator himself started testifying and speaking to the refugees concerning his experience on the trip. The testimonies from the saints who returned from the gospel trip were very encouraging, with many

testifying that their faith was greatly strengthened with the realization that the Lord is gaining every tribe and nation for Himself. During this gospel trip 1,973 persons were contacted for more than 30 seconds. There were 190

appointments, and 152 homes were visited. 156 were lead to pray to receive the Lord, and 4 were baptized.

FIRST LORD'S TABLE MEETING OF THE CHURCH IN BUDAPEST, HUNGARY

Dear brothers and sisters,

It is with great joy that the saints meeting in Budapest, Hungary announce to you the date of the first Lord's Table meeting of the church in Budapest. We thank the Lord and you, dear saints, for all the prayers offered, seeking His timing for the establishment of His table here. We take this step after much prayer and in fellowship with the Body. Our feeling is to have the first table on March 13, 2016.

For those who feel led of the Lord to join us for this gathering, arrangements have been made to meet at Hotel Benczur, located at Benczur 35 in district 6 of Budapest. If hotel accommodations are needed for one or more nights, a form is attached by which you can make the arrangement at the discounted group price that has been extended by the hotel. The buffet dinner on Saturday and lunch on the Lord's Day are joyfully provided for by the local saints. It is our prayer that the Lord will bless this gathering as the taking of the ground in Budapest and will establish His table here as a shining local testimony of His one Body on the earth, declaring His death until He comes.

We can also direct you concerning free car parking from this address. If you will fly into Budapest, shuttle service between the airport and the hotel can be arranged online at www.airportshuttle.com.

Because the saints here are relatively few and we would like for all to be able to attend the meetings, no provision will be made for childcare. There is, however, a public play area adjacent to the hotel property. We hope that families bringing young children can coordinate together for their care.
