# **DETAILED PRAYER BURDENS**

International: Mass Distribution of Gospel and Ministry Materials (March 31-July 5)

Another series of mass distribution trips among the refugees is planned from March 31 through July 5. The distribution teams are made up of saints primarily from Europe, Taiwan, Russia, and the US. Please pray for:

- The blending of the saints who serve on
- The Lord's leading the teams to find the most effective ways to distribute in different situations.
- The openness of the refugees to the Word of God and the Lord's appearing to them as they read it.

#### The Lord's Move in India - The Saints' Constitution in Life and Truth

Pray for the saints in India that they would be brought on in their experience of Christ as life and be richly constituted with the truth through their pursuit of Christ in the Life-Studies and ministry publications.

Pray that through such a constitution of Christ as life and truth many would be equipped and perfected to serve in the labor on the college campuses and on those of the second generation, and that even some would serve in a full-time capacity.

### Local: The Burden for the Increase in the Churches in Southern California

- Continue to pray that the saints in southern California will become desperate to bear fruit for the Lord's increase and that vital groups would be raised up in every locality to pray for this burden and to contact people together to bear remaining
- Pray for the Lord's blessing upon the churches that the God-ordained way to practice the church life in begetting, nourishing and perfecting new believers to build up the Body of Christ would be realized in these days.

#### SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA BLENDING CONFERENCE

Dear leading brothers and saints of the DATES: 4/30-5/1 churches in Southern California,

We would like to announce a blending conference for all of the churches in Southern California to take place on the weekend of April 30 through May 1, 2016. Last spring, we held a similar conference and it was very encouraging to all who attended. This time, the co-workers in Southern California would like to open up a specific burden for all the churches to be brought into one accord for the Lord's Day (5/1): increase and spread of the Lord's recovery.

Concerning the matter of the increase, Brother Lee said:

Today in the Lord's recovery the greatest need, the primary need, is to gain the increase. A house cannot be built without materials. We need to save sinners through the preaching of the gospel that they may become material for the building up of the church as the house of God.... If we mean business with the Lord for His recovery, we need to consider our present situation seriously. We should not be comfortable concerning the present situation of the Lord's recovery, especially regarding the matter of increase.

We look forward to the opportunity for all the saints in the churches in Southern California to be perfected into one through this special gathering!
