"Don't bring anyone, or anything. Don't do anything....He just wants us. He just wants to infuse us with Himself." The Lord Jesus wants to reveal Himself to us stage by stage. It's gradual. It's progressive. We all saw something of Christ this week, and the brothers urged us to continue after the training. Don't stop seeing! I really enjoyed that God does not want us to come with anything—neither our baggage nor our expectations. We often expect to get something out of our time with Him. We expect and ask for things like peace, joy, a good day, etc. However, He simply wants us to be there to behold Him as our GOD. The Lord Jesus is our God before anything else, and He wants us to come just as we are, to spend time to behold Him face to face. If we give Him the ground, and simply just come and "be there," He will supply us with Himself, and meet our every need! —William J.
