## DETAILED PRAYER BURDENS

**International: The Lord's Move in Germany**  
*(for additional details, see the full letter from brother Tom Goetz on page 2)*

- ☉ Beseech the Lord of the harvest that He would thrust out workers into His harvest that more saints would visit and migrate to Germany to shepherd and feed the hundreds of refugees who have been contacted that they may be gained as Christ's increase.
- ☉ Pray that refugees could find suitable, inexpensive apartments in the 4 main cities where the saints are laboring that they themselves can open their homes for gaining their friends.
- ☉ Pray for the refugees who have been scattered throughout Germany, pray for the raising up of gospel teams to visit these refugees that the refugees could be gathered together to become local churches.
- ☉ Pray for the local saints that their capacity, heart and burden would be enlarged to care for all the new ones being contacted and that a healthy, vital small group church life would be built up in the

churches that those being cared for would be solidly added to the church life.

- ☉ Pray that the Lord's testimony would be fully recovered in this country and even shine brighter than in former times that His testimony would become prevailing in Germany. Pray that the Lord would even gain hundreds and thousands of local Germans, especially young people and students, to be part of this testimony.

**Local: College Work at UCI and IVC**

- ☉ Pray for the labor on these campuses and for all the new ones being contacted that they would be shepherded into the church life.

**Local Perfecting Conference—October 2**

- ☉ Pray for the full release of the Lord's current burden to the church and the church's receiving and response to this burden.

## LOCAL PERFECTING CONFERENCE ON OCTOBER 2ND

The church in Irvine will have a two-session local perfecting conference on Lord's Day morning, October 2, at Hall 1. The purpose of the conference is to introduce a present burden to all the saints for the strengthening of the church.

The local perfecting conference will be held during the usual hours for the Lord's Day morning meetings with a short break in between the two sessions. Immediately following the conference will be a church-provided love feast.

To accommodate the conference schedule, the **Lord's Table will be corporate** (with all languages combined) and will be moved to **early evening** (5:00pm – 5:45pm) at **Hall 1**. ## GERMANY UPDATE FROM BRO. TOM GOETZ

Here are some prayer requests concerning our labor. Thank you for your kind remembrance of us.

1) We have hundreds of names of new ones and each one of these new ones (refugees) is connected to many more in many other places. Our most basic and fundamental need is for more manpower. In Matt. 9:36-38, it says "And seeing the crowds, He was moved with compassion for them, because they were harassed and cast away like sheep not having a shepherd. Then He said to His disciples, The harvest is great, but the workers few; Therefore beseech the Lord of the harvest that He would thrust out workers into His harvest." We have to beseech, not merely pray, to the Lord of the harvest that He would thrust out (not merely send out) workers into His harvest. We need many who can come and shepherd and feed them, we need more who will move here and open their homes as shepherd's tents to receive them and gain them.

2) The refugees are being processed and sent all over Germany. We hope and pray that as they are sent out to the towns and villages all over Germany they will be like seeds of the gospel wherever the Sower happens to scatter them. We need gospel teams that can travel around from place to place to visit them in their homes and gather the seeking ones in many places across Germany. Under the Lord's administration, each of these little clusters can become a local church.

3) Another item related to their being processed is our desire to locate many of them right here in Dusseldorf so they can enter into the church life here and be built up with the saints in the church life. We are afraid that after so much time and labor the government will send them away to distant places. Our prayer is that we could find suitable, inexpensive small flats nearby the saints where the

landlord would be willing to rent to a refugee family. Then, they also can become an open home for gaining more of their friends.

4) The churches in Germany were caught off-guard by this sudden influx of new ones and gospel trips. The capacity of the saints and the burden within them needed to be quickly enlarged. Now that there are so many fish in our nets, we need to bring them solidly into the boat, the church life. For this the churches need further enlarging in our capacity, heart, and burden to receive them and gain them as remaining fruit. We recently began a local perfecting training on the small group church life. Our burden is that we all can see a fresh vision of the practice of the God-ordained way to build up the church through the small vital groups. Please pray for the working out of all we are seeing.

5) Finally, the Lord's recovery in Europe began in Germany in 1971. Because of the turmoil that hit Europe in the late 1980s, the testimony here was nearly eliminated completely. It is very clear that the Lord is visiting Germany in a intensified way in these days to rebuild what was torn down and to recover the damaged testimony of the local churches in Germany. Please pray for the recovery of the Lord's testimony here to be greater and more glorious than the former times. Before the end of the age, the Lord's testimony here must be recovered in a prevailing way. We pray that the Lord would gain hundreds and thousands of the local German people, especially the young people and students.
