DETAILED PRAYER BURDENS

International: European International Blending Conference (October 21-23) in Baarlo, Netherlands

- ☉ Pray for the Lord's rich speaking in this time that the saints in Europe will be further blended together in the Lord's up-to-date speaking and that the Lord's move throughout Europe will be strengthened through this time.

The Lord's move in Krakow, Poland

By the end of October six full-timers who previously served in the UK will relocate to Krakow and will begin to serve there to raise up the Lord's testimony. Please pray:

- ☉ That suitable housing will be found for all the full-timers.
- ☉ That all the full-timers will be blended together in prayer and fellowship to serve in one accord.
- ☉ That the labor in Krakow will be fruitful under the Lord's abundant blessing.
- ☉ That a golden lampstand will be raised up as the testimony of Jesus in Krakow.

Local: The church in Irvine being a church in God's Word

- ☉ Pray that all the saints will have a renewed taste and love for God's word that we would desire to read it daily, receive it by means of all prayer for our spiritual nourishment and study it to be a people constituted with the truth and be the church as the pillar and base of the truth.

REPORT FROM NAPLES, ITALY

A group of approximately 19 Italian believers in Naples have been receiving the ministry books from Rhema for several years. They shared with their pastors what they were seeing regarding the ground of oneness and the church life and were cast out of their denomination. Among themselves they determined to take the "way of the recovery" and began to meet earlier this year. We have met with them now on approximately 5 occasions both in Rome and in Naples.

These times are so anointed by the Lord Spirit, and we have the strong feeling that the Lord is personally shepherding them step-by-step into His recovery. In a recent visit we shared from the outline from the *Crystallization-Study of Exodus* on going outside the camp and entering within the veil, which was just where these precious saints are in their experience of leaving the denominations and learning to exercise their spirit. As we were

sharing, there were tears in the eyes of some of these saints. When we opened the time for testimonies, one couple shared how they felt led by the Lord to return to Italy from Spain for "something new," but they did not know what it was until that night. A sister shared that the Lord told her in a dream that He would lead her into what He was doing on the earth. A brother with a small family shared that now that they have left the denominations, they need to see what a local church looks like. They need an example so that they do not repeat the religion that they left. We encouraged them to visit other churches, such as the church in Rome and other local churches, when they are traveling. We also encouraged them to attend the conferences in London (in the spring) and Baarlo (this month). Please keep these saints in your prayers.

UPDATE: NEW TESTAMENT READING CHALLENGE / LIFE-STUDY OF EZEKIEL

New Testament Reading Challenge

Starting Monday, Oct. 10, the church commenced its **New Testament Reading Challenge** in which all participants read one chapter of the New Testament for six days during the week (with one day for make-up).

If we faithfully follow this schedule to read the word daily ("We need to be legal in coming to the Word daily."), the whole church can complete the 260 chapters of the New Testament in early August of next year!

This proposed reading schedule is not intended to replace existing Bible reading schedules, but rather to supplement them. Due to its slower pace, it can easily be adopted

by those who desire to start reading the Bible regularly, as well as be used as a tool to help others develop a Bible-reading habit by reading it together as companions! May the Word of Christ could dwell in us richly!

Life-Study of Ezekiel

Starting Monday, Oct. 17, the church will start a **three-chapter-per-week** reading of the Life-Study of Ezekiel in preparation for the 2016 Winter Training, which will be the *Crystallization Study of Ezekiel*.

Since there are only 27 chapters in the Life-Study of Ezekiel, those who participate in this program will be able to complete the read-
