International: Rhema Books — Translation, Printing and Distribution

Books for mass distribution are soon to be printed in Sinhala (Sri Lanka), Burmese (Myanmar), Bangla (Bangladesh) and in the Indian languages of Marathi, Kannada and Mizo. Translation and editing are in the process for Vietnamese, Urdu (Pakistan) and Khmer (Cambodia) and more languages are being prepared. To serve the free mass distribution of these books, a warehouse is being setup in Taiwan.

- ⊗ Please pray for the saints and all those involved in the various stages of translation and printing that all in Asia will have the opportunity to taste the ministry of the age in their native tongue.
- ⊗ Pray that the Lord would cause the warehouse in Taiwan to be a blessing, even that it would be Joseph's storehouse to supply spiritual food to the multitudes in Asia.

DISTRICT ADJUSTMENT PLAN (COMMENCING AUG. 20, 2017)

Over the last several months, the leading and responsible brothers in the church in Irvine have been working on a plan to address a number of particular needs identified in various districts. After five years of meeting in districts, we have learned much about the practice of districting. Most of the experience has been overwhelmingly positive, but there are certain areas that could use some adjustment. So with a view to giving all the districts a chance for a "new beginning," we have embarked on a revised district plan that would include the following:
