International: The Lord's Move in India

In a recent gospel propagation over ten days in the New Delhi area there were 89 baptisms, including 34 baptisms from Delhi University.

This number of baptisms is unprecedented at Delhi University. This was a great blessing from the Lord. Delhi University is ranked among the top universities in India. We sense the Lord's strong desire to gain the best material for His future move in India. Every time we went out to preach the gospel we would invite students for Bible Studies, and found that many had a desire to know about the Bible.
