## DETAILED PRAYER BURDENS

### International: The Lord's Move in Frankfurt

Most of the saints live in Westend, and the adjacent neighborhood is Ginnheim where the meeting hall is located and where a newly migrated couple just began leasing a house. We obtained city approval to set up a Bible table on Thursday evenings. The location is next to a grocery store and we passed out 12 Bibles to our neighbors last week. We have also set aside two hours (noon - 2 pm) on Saturdays for the local saints to meet at the hall, pray, and go out on the gospel.
