International: Int'l Memorial Day Conference

- ☉ Pray the Lord will have a way to work out all that was spoken at the Memorial Day Conference.

The Lord's Move in Germany

- ☉ Pray for the situation in Munich: 142 interested persons have asked for further contact. Many of these, if not most, are native German-speaking students. There have been many positive responses with at least 34 new ones, and 13 have already come to either a home meeting or a barbecue. There is a great need for a mature American or Canadian couple to migrate to Munich permanently, as well as housing for the saints who are going there to labor.
