A highlight of my term so far has been the blessing of the Lord upon my team. Through His mercy and our prayers, our team has baptized four new ones this month, three on 10/13 and one on 10/14. Anaheim had a gospel meeting on Saturday the 14th, and the three brothers whom we invited decided to get baptized that night. The next day, we visited one of the brothers who got baptized the previous night. There, he and his friends (who also got baptized the previous night) invited another friend.
