LETTER FROM THE LEES

Dear saints,

With mixed feelings we would like you to know that our family is moving to St. Louis, MO.

We have been exercising to be sent by the Lord for the Lord's move and to maintain the life of the tent since we got married. Our burden was eastward to Europe but we felt if we could not yet go to Europe that we should at least go eastward in the U.S. and continue to dig the channel out of Southern California. Here and there we asked the Lord but nothing opened up. We would look at the GTCA cities list and see if there were any job openings in Noah's department in those cities. There have been one here and there but usually in a nearby city and not in the target city.

When we heard about the burden for Middle America at the end of the December training we looked at all the cities and the only one left that really was in the Middle America region and had an office in his department was in St. Louis. Soon after, we found out that some positions were opened up and St. Louis was one of them.

Since Noah got the job in St. Louis and the door is open to us, both of us have peace to follow the Lord to St. Louis at this time.

The Lord has been shepherding us and has graciously given us His personal speaking to assure us that His presence is with us. Henna is open to the idea although is sad to say good-bye to her friends. We pray much for Henna that this move will by no means affect her in a negative way, but rather she will be happy and it will be an opportunity for her to be enlarged. Given that our inner sense and the Lord's outward confirmation are in line with the burden in the Body, we are peaceful to proceed with this move. This feeling has been confirmed by the saints here in Irvine and in St. Louis.

Noah will move first because he has to report to St. Louis on April 29. Huong and Henna will stay so Henna can finish her school year and will join Noah after the July training.
