## DETAILED PRAYER BURDENS

### **International:** FTTA-XB Gospel Trips To Germany (May 1-20)

The FTTA-XB trainees will be going on gospel trips throughout Germany from Wednesday, May 1 to Monday, May 20. Six trainees will be going to Berlin, four trainees to Dusseldorf, four trainees to Frankfurt, and five trainees to Munich and Stuttgart.

☉ Please pray for the safety of the trainees during the trip, for the gospel to go forth in all these cities, and for the trainees to have a taste of the Lord's move in Europe.

### **The Nordic Countries**

There are currently six churches in the Nordic countries (Sweden, Norway, Finland and Denmark) and they are all small localities, ranging from ten to forty saints. The burden in these countries is for the increase in the localities and the spreading to new cities, of which there are three cities where there are saints living who are in close fellowship with the other churches.

### MINISTRY PORTION

#### FORGIVING THE SINS OF THE SICK

##### A Sinner Paralyzed by Sin

Mark 2:4 says, "And not being able to bring him to Him because of the crowd, they removed the roof where He was; and having dug through, they lowered the bed on which the paralytic was lying." Their zeal in seeking the Slave-Savior's healing compelled the seekers to break through the proper barrier—something which might be considered a wild deed. Then through the roof they lowered the bed, a small mattress or pad, on which the sick man was lying.

Verse 5 says, "And Jesus, seeing their faith, says to the paralytic, Child, your sins are forgiven!" This faith, issuing from hearing the word of Christ (Rom. 10:17), indicates that the seekers had heard of the Slave-Savior.

Seeing their faith, the Lord called the paralytic a "child." This loving word of the Slave-Savior implies kindness. Here the Lord's human virtue was expressed.

The Lord said to the paralytic, "Your sins are forgiven!" Sins were the cause of his sickness. The Slave-Savior's word here touched the cause so that there might be a different effect. Once the sins were forgiven, the sickness was healed.

It is important and meaningful that the first incident in this section on the carrying out of the gospel service is a case of forgiving the sins of a sick person. This indicates that in carrying out the gospel the first thing that must be done is to help people have their sins forgiven.
