## LETTER FROM THE TRAINING

...[I]t is a privilege to have gone through the training. There are life practices I've experienced in the training which have strengthened my relationship with the Lord. One of my favorite practices has been the afternoon time with the Lord to absorb Him. A hymn which I have enjoyed before the Lord is hymn 171, which is on the beauty of the Lord. This is my favorite stanza:

"Oh, Thou art fairer than the fair,  
And sweeter than the sweet;  
Beside Thee, none in heaven or earth,  
Our heart's desire could meet."

The last two lines remind me of Psalms 73:25:  
"Whom do I have in heaven *but You*?  
And besides You there is nothing I desire on earth."

One of my aspirations is for the Lord to become my only desire. In my afternoon times with the Lord, I get a taste of what this means. The more I spend time with Him, the

more I see His beauty, and the more I am willing to let go of everything else. In light of the Memorial Day Weekend Conference we just concluded, a golden nugget I take and share with you is that as we see and experience who the Lord is, the more we realize His worth. We realize that gaining Christ far exceeds anything we ever possessed, desire to possess, and honor about ourselves. All these things added together do not compare to the Christ we possess and are gaining. We count all things as refuse on account of the excellency of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord (Philippians 3:8). After this conference, I am left with a prayer: "Lord, make me desperate to pursue after You." There is a feeling within that gaining Christ is not for my own benefit alone; rather, it is for His kingdom. We are preparing today for the wedding feast in the next age, and for His Kingdom to be established.
