DETAILED PRAYER BURDENS

International: Bible Distribution in Germany

From June 20-22, 5,925 Bibles were distributed at the Kirchentag event (an assembly of members of the Evangelical Church in Germany) in Dortmund, Germany.

- ☉ Pray that the Lord will bless every Bible that was passed out and that He will find good ground in the hearts of the recipients.
- ☉ Pray that He will bring many recipients into contact with the saints in the churches.

National: Graduating Trainees

- ☉ Pray for each graduate of the FTTA to follow the Lamb wherever He may lead them, that He would open all the doors to enable them to do so, and that they would live to Him as full-timers, whether job-dropping, job-taking, school-attending, or whatever their status.

Semi-annual Training (July 1-6)

- ☉ Pray for the strong and unhindered release of the Lord's up-to-date word and burden, that His recovery would advance to another stage, to match His move at the end of this age.

- ☉ Pray for all the speaking brothers, that they would be filled with the essential and economical Spirit in speaking the word of God with all boldness and with the God-given utterance.

- ☉ Pray for the saints to give themselves fully to this training, to maintain a sanctified atmosphere in their homes, and to faithfully dive into the messages and blend with others in the study groups.

North America College Training (July 14-20)

- ☉ Pray for all the serving saints from around the country and across the globe, that they would enjoy the anointing of the Spirit and the supply of grace to be kept in absolute oneness and to have the one accord that would invite the Lord's blessing

- ☉ Pray that the 303 recent high school graduates—incoming freshmen—would genuinely and personally touch the Lord and consecrate their college years to the Lord.

2019 JULY TRAINING

One of the greatest blessings to the Lord's recovery has been the semi-annual trainings. This week we will enjoy the 2019 July Training to be held in Anaheim and by simulcast in Irvine (Hall 3 for English & Korean-speaking; Hall 1 for Chinese-speaking). As a reminder to all those who are registered, the afternoon and evening sessions start at 4:00pm and 7:30pm, respectively.

Due to the special nature of the trainings (as opposed to church conferences), specific regulations do apply. For instance, we are required to be in our seats 5 minutes early. If we are unable to participate in a training session, we must notify in advance the brothers designated as "attendance coordinators."

Saints participating in the training are also required to study the training messages in groups of 8-10. Where the situation permits, these study times should take place in a nearby home, but those who are unable to study in the homes can study at Hall 1 throughout the week from 9am-12pm.

All college and high school students participating in the training must attend a study session held daily at the LSM campus in Anaheim from 9:00-11:30am.

May the Lord bless the upcoming training with His fresh and up-to-date speaking!

However, we are allowed to have three open meetings in the webcast in Irvine, and these will be the last three messages of the training: **the evening meeting only for Friday, July 5, and the afternoon and evening meetings for Saturday, July 6.**

PRAYER FOR NORTH AMERICA COLLEGE TRAINING

The second North America College Training (NACT) is upon us in less than a month. The first training took place in the summer of 2015, at which time it was decided that the event should occur once every four years in order to allow every college student among us the opportunity to participate at least once in their college years.

Approximately 1800 saints (with 1,200 college students) attended the training in 2015. Many students were deeply inspired to eventually enroll in the Full-time Training in Anaheim (FTTA) in the subsequent years.

This summer, 2800 saints (with 1,900 college students from 385 campuses and 41 countries) have registered to join the training—representing a 55% increase in enrollment compared to four years ago! This is a sign both of the Lord's abundant blessing upon His recovery and of a heart and hunger for God among a new generation of our young people.

We now bring to you our deepest burden related to this upcoming training, that is, the need for much and thorough PRAYER AT THE INCENSE ALTAR BEFORE THE THRONE. In sincerity and boldness, therefore, we ask that you join us in earnest and persistent intercession on behalf of the NACT this year. Specifically, we hope to have forty days (June 11—July 20, the last day of the training) of dedicated prayer on the part of the churches and the saints in the following five general directions:

- ☉ To fully gain a new generation of college-age saints for God's eternal purpose of Christ and the church—Psa 24:6; Eph 1:9-10.

- ☉ To bind the strong man Satan and to plunder his house of young vessels chosen by the Lord for His use—Matt 12:29; 2 Tim 2:21.
- ☉ To prepare the hearts, strengthen the spirits, and preserve the health of the saints so that they can partake of the training—Eph 3:16-17; 1 Thes 5:23.
- ☉ To grant the serving saints the love, faith, grace, wisdom, energy, and endurance to minister to the young people—1 Thes 1:3; 1 Tim 2:1.
- ☉ To rule over all things in the outward environment (weather, transportation, food and lodging, safety) related to the training—Rom 8:28; Eph 1:22.

We believe that forty days of persevering prayer in one accord will yet again result in an unprecedented move of the Holy Spirit in this generation of college saints during the upcoming NACT. May the Lord arm the churches as watchtowers and empower many saints as watchmen to command God to bless the work of His own hands (Isa. 45:11)! May another generation of college-age saints be ushered into the enjoyment and proclamation of the age of Jubilee!

Related to this burden, a new website 40daysprayer.com has been launched to give a daily countdown and a mini post on the particulars of different aspects of the training. We urge you to check it out daily.

MINISTRY EXCERPT

To Fight Together with God and for God

As a priestly army, God's chosen and redeemed people fought together with God and for God. If we would fight together with God and for God today, we must first move, walk, and live with Him and also pass through many things in the wilderness. Only in this way can we be qualified to fight together with God.

The children of Israel fought not only with God but also for God. In the church life today, we should also fight for God. This indicates that our church life is actually for God and not mainly for us. However, our feeling concerning the church life may be too subjective and selfish. In the meeting someone may testify, saying, "Before I came into the church life, I was homeless. Now in the church I am at home. Oh, how good is the church life!" Yes, we are at home in the church life. Nevertheless, we need to realize that the church life is not mainly for us but for God. We should

be able to say, "Lord, the church life is actually Your life. You want to live this way, and we are living together with You. If we did not live and move with You, You would not have Your satisfaction. You do not want to be alone. You have chosen, redeemed, and saved us to accompany You in Your move. Our church life, Lord, is really for You."
