REPORT ON SISTER JOYCE GOETZ'S HEALTH CONDITION

Tom and Joyce Goetz followed the Lamb from Irvine to Germany to live Christ and serve the Lord and the churches there. Over the past several months, Joyce has been suffering from a chronic dry cough. After undergoing a series of tests, Joyce was diagnosed with an adenocarcinoma in her right lung which was identified as a metastatic breast cancer (from 1997) that has now appeared in her lung. At this time, the tumor has only been found in the lung, and at 2.2 cm is still quite small, which would indicate it can be treated. Consultation with doctors is continuing, and a course of treatment will be determined.

Tom and Joyce do not feel that their time in Germany is finished, nor that they should

move permanently back to the United States at this time. But they acknowledge that these things are truly in the Lord's hands, not theirs. Just as they answered the Lord's call to move to Germany, they are ready to follow Him again as He leads them in triumph.

Tom and Joyce's realization is that because they live in the Body, what affects them also affects the other members. They would appreciate the prayer of the saints and the churches, but not in a natural way. As we are in the Lord's ascension, may we pray the prayers that bind the enemy and release the Lord to have His way to carry out His purpose in and through the Goetzes. May the Lord get the glory and the enemy get all the shame.
