DETAILED PRAYER BURDENS

International: One-week trainings at Bower House in London

The saints in Europe are in the midst of a series of one-week trainings at Bower House in London that will continue through November 23rd. The overall theme of the trainings is *The Four Great Pillars in the Lord's Recovery: Truth, Life, the Church and the Gospel*.

- ⊗ Pray that the participating saints, including new ones and radio and publication contacts, will receive a vision of each of the four crucial pillars in the Lord's recovery.
- ⊗ Pray for mutual encouragement and a deeper realization of the Body as a result of the participants' blending with the church in London, other surrounding churches, and the trainees in the Full-Time Training in London (FTTL).
- ⊗ Pray that the participants will receive much practical help from the fellowship regarding their daily life, the vital groups, the spread of the divine truths throughout Europe, being fruit-bearing branches in the vine, and developing their function for the building up of the local churches.

German and Persian Translators

On November 9, there was a training in Frankfurt, Germany for the saints who have a burden for German and Persian translation.

- ⊗ Pray for the Lord to gain more saints in the recovery who have proficiency in these languages.
- ⊗ Pray for the perfecting of the saints in their written and oral translation skills, which will be a great benefit to both the

translation of the ministry publications in these languages, as well as to the translation of the ministry of the word at trainings and conferences and in the weekly church meetings.

Local: Gospel Prayer

- ⊗ Pray for the spirit of supplication to fill the church and the saints in Irvine, that the burden of the gospel may be borne and carried out by prayer.
- ⊗ Pray that there would be daily, persistent, persevering prayer that would move God's hand to bind Satan and release the chosen ones who are held captive by him.
- ⊗ Pray for the saints to bring names to the Lord, to entreat the Lord specifically for the salvation of particular persons, and to be led concerning the Lord's specific work in each one.

Gospel Meeting—November 22

- ⊗ Pray for the ones in whom God has been moving to receive an invitation to the gospel meeting, and to accept the invitation and come.
- ⊗ Pray for the release of a saving word, spoken by the Spirit, that would subdue the listeners, infuse them with faith and cause them to call upon the name of the Lord.
- ⊗ Pray for the coordination of the saints in all the services for the gospel meeting, that we would function as a priesthood of the gospel, and that every part of our service would be a factor in causing the gospel contacts to be saved.

OUR NEED FOR PARTICULAR HEALING

Spiritually speaking, our relationship with God depends upon the hearing organ, the speaking organ, and the seeing organ. If we cannot hear God's word, if we cannot talk to God, and if we cannot see God's vision, we cannot have any relationship with Him. If such were our situation, we would be like a dumb idol standing before God. Therefore, we need the healing of our hearing, speaking, and seeing organs.

The New Testament reveals that, spiritually speaking, we were dead, but the Lord Jesus has made us alive. When He came to us and sowed Himself into us, we were enlivened. We were then healed of our fever, leprosy, paralysis, and withered condition.

Praise the Lord that we have been made alive, that we have been regenerated! However, after being regenerated, we may still be deaf, dumb, and blind, in need of the Lord's particular healing. Was this not your experience with the Lord? I can testify that it was my experience. I was regenerated in 1925, but it was not until 1932 that my ears began to hear God's voice, my eyes began to see His vision, and my mouth was opened to speak for God. I praise Him that today, through His mercy, I can hear, speak, and see.
