TRAINEE LETTER

We report testimonies written by our Irvine-sent and Irvine-related trainees regarding their enjoyment and experience in the FTTA for the encouragement of all the saints.

Today marks the beginning of the first regular week of my last term of the training and I can testify that the Lord can use a sense of desperation to go higher and deeper in us. Last night my house had an awesome meal together and a time of singing and enjoying and it was a wonderful and enjoyable time to get to know in a deeper way the three first terms that were placed in the house.

This past week was my last pre-training and before this term I was desperate before the Lord that I would come as an empty and open vessel without any concept or past experience to blind me. I feel that the Lord very much answered this prayer because every day of pre-training in the midst of classes I had heard before, and a schedule I was familiar with, I received daily light and truth!

My highlight from last week's pre-training classes came from a fellowship regarding the Life Cycle from 1 John 1:1-9 where we see a cycle that spirals us from where we are all the way to the New Jerusalem. Our concept of confession is often that we come to the Lord with a list of things we feel that we need to confess, and that we re-

quire a feeling of guilt and sorrow in order to become right with the Lord. But in 1 John we see that the goal is always life and fellowship. Actually this is how we start every time with the Lord. We come to Him for life and fellowship, and then because He is light itself, He may touch something in our being. This causes us to confess by agreeing with that light and applying the blood, and then IMMEDIATELY we can enter back into sweet fellowship with the Lord. I feel in the past that Satan had defrauded me of much sweet time with the Lord, but no more! Simply come to Him, confess, and keep enjoying!
