## DETAILED PRAYER BURDENS

### International: Azerbaijan

☉ Pray that the Lord will sustain and build up the dozen college students among the saints, and that in the coming semester He will graciously add three more local college students as remaining fruit.

### Beginning of Spring Semester of Full-Time Training in London (FTTL) – February 7

☉ Pray that the Lord will bless this new semester and have a way through the FTTL to raise up the university graduates in Europe to be living members of His Body and overcomers for His bride.

### Germany

☉ Pray for the Lord's leading as the churches in the German-speaking countries enter into a new phase of the God-ordained way training in the new year, and that the saints will go to the Lord desperately to have a breakthrough to overcome deadness, lukewarmness, and barrenness, and to become seeds that are sown for the production of genuine vital groups.

☉ Pray that the Lord will grant the saints wisdom and His leading in the care and shepherding of the Farsi-speaking saints.

☉ Pray for the release of the building permit for the church in Stuttgart to be able to move ahead with the acquisition of a property to be used as a meeting hall.

### Local: Bible Distribution and Gospel Outreach

☉ Pray for the Bibles for America ("BfA") table that is being set up on Saturdays in Irvine, that many hungry Christians and unbelievers will stop by, converse with the saints, and receive Bibles, tracts and other literature.

☉ Pray for the ones who left their contact information, that they would respond to the saints' follow-up and begin to have appointments to read the Bible.

☉ Pray that more saints will participate in the BfA table and in the gospel outreach, and that this labor will be sustained, so that the word of the truth can be spread in Irvine and the Body testimony can be seen.

### Campus Work

☉ Pray that the resumption of in-person classes and the opening up of campus facilities will lead to more contact between the saints and the new students, and that the new students will become established in the Lord's Day meetings, in the small groups, and in having regular appointments with the saints.
